- ✓ Do I have a valid student visa?
- ✓ Do I have Overseas Students Health Cover (OSHC) for the duration of my stay?
- ✓ Do I have a valid passport?
- ✓ Do I have a plane ticket?
- ✓ Are my finances in order and do I have enough funds to support myself?
- ✓ Did I organise airport transport (if required)?
- ✓ Do I have accommodation?
- ✓ Have I studied the information provided on living and studying in Australia?
- ✓ Did I research SBTA/SELA's website and the course I will be studying?
